One minute public comment (280 words)

Regarding item 8.1, Building a Better Westchester-Playa wishes to address mis-information found in the agenda attachment on this topic (titled gmail_please_help_westchester).

The attachment argues our community is being "set up to become the Westside's containment zone for homeless."

Yes, ED1 allows for either shelter or 100% affordable density bonus buildings.

However, acquiring Westchester-Playa land is expensive. Thus far, all ED1 applicants in CD-11 are private developers whose financial models require *rent-paying tenants*. Our 6 current local ED1 applications commit, *in writing*, to renting to "Low Income" and "Moderate Income" tenants. This means:

Low Income = a single person making no more than \$77,000

Moderate Income = the income cap is \$82,500

This same agenda attachment argues "Westchester (has the) most ED1 projects in the council district."

As of today, West LA has 7. Mar Vista has 7. Westchester has 6. In total, CD11 has a total of 20 projects in review, while other council districts have 30, 40 or 50 ED1 projects.

Finally, the same attachment states that "We now have official confirmation that our unsheltered homeless count increased by about 250% from the LAHSA point-in-time count in 2023 to the count in 2024."

The LAHSA homeless count is an estimate performed by volunteers from the community rather than an official census. More importantly, from the <u>LAHSA dashboard</u> map titled "Homeless Count Within City of LA By Council District", CD-11 had 2,125 homeless in 2023 and 1,779 homeless in 2024 (in all forms). This represents a 16% **decrease** from 2023 to 2024, not a 250% increase. See table below. There is a significant increase in the number of unsheltered homeless, from 460 to 546 which is a 19% increase.
